ROLE OF CLASS TEACHER

Class Teacher act as local guardians for Students of their respective classes. They will be in close contact with the students and observe the attendance, discipline and the academic progress of the students of their sections.

Parents can meet the Head Mistress during the working hours of the School to know about the progress, attendance and activities of their child in the school.

Parents can meet the Class Teacher or Subject Teachers between 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. on working days.

GENERAL RULES OF THE SCHOOL

All Students must strictly follow the school rules given below and maintain discipline.

- a) Pupils must be punctual and regular in attending school.
- b) Pupil should come to school wearing the prescribed uniform. The uniform should be neat and tidy.
- c) Pupil **SHOULD NOT** wear gold and silver ornaments, fancy hair clips, earrings, watches and Mehandi.
- d) Pupils must do their homework and other assignments in time.
- e) Pupils must be in possession of their identity cards while attending the school.
- f) Pupils must participate in extra-curricular activities.
- g) Pupils must attend tests and exams without fail.
- h) Pupils must utilize school Library during off periods.
- i) Proper utilisation of School Toilets including flushing with water and avoiding of clogging in W.C., on any account will be strictly compiled with.
- j) Since other Educational Institutions function in the same premises, students will have to maintain maximum silence while entering or leaving the school avoiding loud gossip, laughter etc., in the quadrangle, classrooms and school veranda.
- k) Pupils are prohibited to bring mobile phones or any electronic gadgets.Once confiscated, such items WILL NOT be returned.
- 1) Pupils are expected to show respect to all teachers and elders.
- m) Pupil must exhibit polite behaviour and good manners.
- n) Pupil found guilty of any kind of misbehaviour will be sternly dealth with.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PARENTS

- Parents are requested to co-operate with the school to enforce regularity and discipline.
- Parents should abstain from taking leave during working days, unless there is a genuine reason.
- Parents should send leave letter duly signed when the pupil return to the school after taking leave. If the leave exceeds more than three days parents should meet the Head Mistress.
- Parents must ensure that their child is regular in doing home works and assignments.
- Parents should inform the school whenever there is a change in the address or phone numbers.
- ✤ Parents must attend all the Parent Teacher meet without fail.
- Parents should avoid critical remarks about teachers or school in presence of the children. If there is any genuine problem it can be discussed with the Head Mistress or the concerned teacher.
- Parents should follow the progress of their child and co-operate with the teachers to provide remedy in learning process.
- Parents are encouraged to consult teachers/head mistress about any problem regarding their child and can take the help of school counsellor if necessary.
- Current new syllabus and CCE system of Examination will be followed in our school.
- Parents must instruct their children to report immediately to them/ teachers or other authorities of any strange, unusual/immodest behaviour of people or situation inside or outside the school premises.
- Parents must ensure their children come with drinking water since milk and nutritious midday meal is provided in the school.
- Since the building is situate at the corner of cross roads 15th cross, east park road, west park road, margosa road, the flow of vehicular traffic is considerable. All road safety precautions must be strictly followed while entering or leaving the school premises.
